

## NPF Objectives:


### NPF aims to achieve the following objectives:

- Contributing in the follow up of the prisoners cases and advocating the fair ones.
- Working towards releasing the indebted prisoners who were jailed for failing to pay debts.
- Taking care of the needy families of prisoners.
- Contributing toward raising awareness in the society on the risks and consequences of crime.
- Activating the role of the society in solving the prisoners' cases.
- Clearing stereotypes around prisoners in the society.
- Working with the official bodies to improve the quality of prison food.
- Working towards improving the educational level of prisoners.
- Providing healthcare and psychotherapy to prisoners
- Contributing to prisoners' rehabilitation and addressing the motives for crime.
- Rehabilitating prisoners to enter the labor market and providing employment opportunities after their release.
- Training the people in charge of prisons (from the administrative, right and human aspects). Supporting prison infrastructures
- Contributing toward the improvement of the judiciary, prosecution and security mechanisms.
- Contributing toward taking care of the female prisoners children and juveniles while attending to their age and reintegrating them in the society.

Protection Program aims to provide rights protection for male, female, juvenile prisoners and the accompanying children in accordance with the related international human rights provisions and conventions, assist the prisoners to realize their rights and fulfill their duties, and help the concerned authorities to implement prisoners right, finalize the pending cases in courts, and monitor human rights violations in prisons that endanger the lives of prisoners to be addressed in cooperation with the appropriate authorities and concerned local and international NGOs.

#### **Program Target Beneficiaries:**

(Prisoners- Prison authorities and working staff- Concerned about Prisons).

- To pay instead of the insolvent prisoners who have completed the common right and remained in prison due to inability to pay the special right (End Insolvency).
- To plead and defend for poor prisoners' pending issues in the courts and prosecutions (Legal Assistance).
- To legally counsel and advise female and male prisoners and for their legal representatives who follow up on their cases
- Provision of psychosocial support to prisoners and female prisoners and their families to contribute in easing the negative impact of the prison.
- Dissemination of social peace through reconcile the differences between the prisoner and rightful claimant
- To contribute to combating violence against women and children through activating the international laws which ensure their legal rights.
- To improve the mental picture of prisoners and their families in the surrounding community
- Monitor and report and human rights violations within prisons or courts.





NPF aims through the Food Security Program (FSP) to minimize food security deterioration in Yemeni Prisons and enhance the food condition of prisoners) families. Food Security Program benefits the inmates of Central Corrections, Remand Prisons, Police Stations, ICDs, as well as the needy of prisoners) families and released prisoners.

The program exists as a response of the ongoing food security exacerbation in prisons due to the significant increase of prisons) inmates and inability to provide them and their families with the necessary food requirements

- Providing sufficient hygiene requirements for the prison and medical facilities.
- Contributing in holding cleanliness campaigns that cover all the prisons' facilities.



### **ECP Education &** Culture Program **NPF**



We aim through ECP program to create educational environment among prisons, prisoners and juvenile inmates in a manner to contribute in eradication of illiteracy and dropping out within prisons. Through this program, classes are furnished, educational means are provides, coordination for prisoners to continue their education in out-side-prison educational agencies is managed, Illiteracy teaching classes are adopted as well as libraries are provided with books inside prisons.

#### **Program Beneficiaries:**

(Prisons- Prisoners- Prisoners- Families – Released).

- To contribute in illiteracy eradication of female and male prisoners with various age.
- To participate in minimizing the educational dropping out of school among the juvenile prisoners and children.
- To rehabilitate the educational facilities in prisons.
- To contribute in educational tools provision.
- To contribute in furnishing prisons libraries and enrichment with educational and scientific books.
- Holding educational seminars and meetings in prisons.





This program is meant to enhance the shelter of male, female & juvenile prisoners through the provision of blankets, mattresses, pillows, sheets, kitchen tools, solar power system, seasonal clothes, washing machines, and housewares for prisons.

#### **Program Target Beneficiaries:**

(Prisoners- Prisons- Prisoners- Families- Released).

- To contribute to the provision of linen, blankets and sheets (for prisoners and their families to be protected from cold).
- To contribute to furnish prison's kitchens.
- To rehabilitate the Central Washing Machines in the prisons and provide in-house washing machines to women and juveniles.
- To provide garbage collective requirements within prisons and prisons' shelter tools.
- To contribute in provision of solar power for prisons.



# **CBP** Capacity-Building Program and Livelihood Enhancement **NPF**



Capacity -Building Program aims to qualify the prisoners to labor market so to be able to face the living condition after release beside qualify their children for the purpose of enhancing family livelihood. Moreover, this program implments rehabilitation programs that assist in integrating the prisoners within communities after release, in addition to rehabilitating those in charge of prisons so to deal with prisoners according to the international standards and human rights conventions whereby their dignity and humanity is maintained.

#### **Program Target Beneficiaries:**

(Prisons – Prisoners- prisoners- Families- Prison Workers – Released Prisoners).

- Rehabilitating of the prisoner for labor market.
- Capacity building of a productive person for each poor prisoner's family.
- Integrating prisoners into the society.
- Rehabilitating prisons' officials so to be able to deal professionally with prisoners.
- Providing the subsequent care to the released prisoners.



### WCP Women & Child Program **NPF**



We aim, through the Woman and Child's program to uphold the rights of women prisoners and their accompanying children, provide prisoners with education, protection and social welfare programs, protect women prisoners and their children from falling victims of gross violations, stand up to violence against juvenile and women prisoners and their accompanying children, and to protect prisoners' children and juvenile prisoners within the prisons in cooperation with our partners in government agencies and local and international society organizations, by confronting malnutrition, providing food for women pregnant prisoners.

### **RNP Relief National** Program **NPF**



Given the emergency and extraordinary conditions that our country experiencing, and as a sense of community responsibility, NPF represented by businessmen at top of the list, NPF have launched a program titled the" Relief National Program (NRP) in partnership with civil society organizations to provide relief assistance to the affected IDPs. We seek, through such program, to enhance relief and humanitarian situation in Yemen through the provision of humanitarian aids, psychosocial support, relief assistance material and in-kind at the local level to the affected people and IDPs in order to alleviate their suffering and living conditions in the conflict areas ensuring an effective and sustainable living situation and shelters for IDPs taking in to account the principles of humanitarian work, partnership, neutrality transparency and distribution fairness.
